# 6. I think I may need accommodations in my class, who do I contact?

You should <u>register with Services for Students with Disabilities</u> (SSD) as soon as possible. Once you have a verified individualized accommodation form from SSD, turn in a copy of the signed form to the SNB front desk (or email a copy to UMSN-Proctor@med.umich.edu). You must then show the letter to each of your UMSN instructors (including your PNE instructors) and have them sign the UMSN SSD Letter Confirmation. The signed confirmation forms will also need to be turned into the SNB front desk (or emailed to UMSN-Proctor@med.umich.edu). The process of notifying your instructors and having them sign the confirmation forms will need to be completed at the beginning of each term. Once the forms have been turned in, the UMSN Proctoring Team will work with you and your instructors to coordinate times, proctors and space for your accommodated exams.

# 7. Can students reserve classrooms?

Yes. Students may email <u>UMSN-ClassroomRequests@med.umich.edu</u> to request the use of one of the classrooms for academic purposes. There are two open proctor rooms on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor that are open 24 hours and they are first-come, first-served for students wishing to use them to study.

# 8. How can I get an official transcript?

# 9. If I need a recommendation letter from my Program Director or Dean, who do I contact?

For **graduate students** please contact the specific faculty member you are using as a reference for scholarships and or on applications. For graduation verification or certification you can email <u>UMSN-</u>
