Research Interests

Current research focuses on examination of ways to improve patient –provider communication to improve care delivery and patient outcomes, particularly with high risk adolescent populations. A primary focus is provision of care sensitive to the needs of LGBTQ individuals as well as those experiencing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES). Another major focus the development and evaluation of measures to assess adolescent risk behaviors in primary care settings. Specific measures include: the Rapid Assessment for Adolescent Preventive Services (RAAPS) Questionnaire for adolescent Risk Assessment; and the use of Event History Calendars (EHC) to assess risk behaviors in context and exposure to toxic stress and the TIC Grade evaluation tool to measure clients’ perception of the trauma-informed care received. Another focus is increasing understanding of oral health issues for primary care providers; specifically, the development and evaluation of inter-professional educational modules to improve patient-provider communication about oral health and Type 2 diabetes and address health literacy issues for primary care and dental providers. An on-going interest is the relationship between psychosocial development, health and coping. I co-developed the *Modified Erikson's Psychosocial Stage Inventory (MEPSI)* as an innovative measure of psychosocial development based on Ericksonian theory which has been in use over twenty-five years by researchers in the USA and internationally. I am now taking the lead in evolution of the instrument and increasing opportunities for dissemination of it across disciplines.
