Dr. Hershberger leads an elite team of transdisciplinary investigators and highly skilled clinicians in assisted reproduction, advancing knowledge about the factors influencing decision-making processes and their connections to health behaviors, especially among stigmatized or underrepresented minority groups. She also has a passion for mentoring early- and mid-career scientists and healthcare practitioners, which is reflected in her research. In addition, Dr. Hershberger spearheaded and taught the NURS 566 *Developing Literature Reviews* course to PhD students at the University of Illinois Chicago (UIC) from 2016-2021 where she developed an innovative pedagogy and frameworks that allowed many of her students to publish comprehensive literature reviews.
