Clinical Bottom Line/Effectiveness

Brief Background:

- Shea butter is derived from the nut of the shea tree (Vitellaria paradoxa) (1), which grows in West Africa. It has purportedly been used
 for centuries in Africa for various skin protecting effects.
- Shea butter has been shown to be effective in clinical trials for the treatment of nasal congestion (2) and for reducing serum cholesterol levels and coagulating factors (3).
- Although not currently supported by clinical trials, shea butter has also been marketed as a treatment for a variety of skin conditions including acne, burns, chapped lips, dry skin, eczema, psoriasis, scars, stretch marks, and wrinkles.
- Indications for which there is inconclusive anecdotal evidence for shea butter include its use as an anti-inflammatory topical cream for alleviation of arthritis and rheumatism and its use in bruise and muscle soreness healing.
