

## STATE OF RESIDENCE CHANGE NOTIFICATION

The University of Michigan School of Nursing (UMSN) designs its programs to meet the licensure/certification requirements of as many states as possible. However, some states may have additional requirements for licensure and/or restrictions on UMSN programs based on the method of instructional delivery (i.e. Online Programs). If you intend to become licensed in a state other than Michigan be sure to check with the board of nursing in that state to ensure no additional requirements exist.

Additionally, living in or moving to a state other than Michigan during the course of your UMSN program can potentially add extra licensure/certification requirements. In some cases, UMSN may not be allowed to continue a student's program depending on their state of residence. Therefore, it is important that students notify Compliance Staff immediately (even during the academic year) if they intend to change their state of residence. Compliance Staff and Advisors will then work with students to ensure that they are fully informed of any possible implications moving to a different state may have on the successful completion of their UMSN program and on future licensure/certification.
